3. STARTERS

Due to limited starting slots, there is a strict limit of fifty (50) horses for the Event. Horses competing in higher level events will have priority in starting positions.

STARTERS (CONTINUED)

A list of reserve Horses will be made according to order of submission of entry, and athletes who withdraw will be replaced by riders from the reserve list up to twelve (12) hours prior to the first competition.

Athletes who withdraw after the close of entries and up to twelve (12) hours prior to the first competition will be refunded for half their entry fee on the condition they provide written notice to the Organising Committee. Athletes who withdraw within twelve (12) hours of the first competition must have a valid reason to do so or risk elimination from any competitions they have already competed in and a fine of up to \$50 which must be paid prior to competing at future Melba Equestrian Club events.

4. FEES

Entry Fee per horse (2 tests): Members \$60.00

Non-members \$70.00

Admin Fee: \$15.00

Yard Hire per day (offered to members first): \$10.00

Late Entries surcharge: \$30.00

5. OPTING

All athletes at the same level will compete in the same qualifying test. Where there is a freestyle and normal test available at the level, Athletes must, at time of entry, decide whether they wish to compete in the normal test or the freestyle for the Final test.

6. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING

Rosettes will be awarded to third place in each competition.

It is mandatory for the top three (3) Athletes in each competition to present for the prize-giving ceremony directly after the last horse in the competition.

Failure to present to the steward within six (6) minutes of the last horse's start time will result in immediate elimination from the competition. Athletes who have a start in another competition within 20 minutes of the prize-giving ceremony may apply for an exemption to this requirement.

7. FREESTYLES / SOUND CHECKS

All music must be submitted via horsesporttechnology.au/uploads before 6 AM on the day of the Event.

Athletes competing in Freestyle Competitions may present unmounted for a sound check at 7 AM on the morning of the competition.



8. VOLUNTEERS

This show aims to provide the cheapest possible entries for Athletes. Therefore volunteers are essential for the competition to be able to run. All athletes are requested to volunteer to scribe for one competition - one (1) to one and a half (1.5) hours.

9. NOMINATION / ENTRIES

All nominations must be made through the <u>Melba Equestrian Club Entry Form</u> and must include the Athlete, Horse and Primary Horse Owners Name, Address and EA Numbers.

10. ATHLETE ACCOMMODATION

Non-powered camping may be available on the show grounds with prior notice.

Athletes are welcome to book their own accommodation, please note that there are no guarantees as to the availability of horse facilities near to the venue.
